ABOUT

Campion Hall is hosting a two-week summer school in Forced Migration in collaboration with Jesuit Refugee Service (JRS) and Boston College. Jesuit Refugee Service is an international Catholic organisation with a mission to accompany, service and advocate on behalf of refugees and other displaced persons.

Aimed at Jesuits, especially those in formation, religious sisters and other interested individuals, the course offers an insight into the global situation of forced displacement and reflects on the response of the Church through Catholic Social Teaching. It is hoped that the experience will contribute to the mutual discernment process of participants when considering their ministries, so that the accompaniment and service of refugees will form an important part of discernment.

The summer school is taught in varied formats including lectures, workshops, small group discussions and presentations, films and excursions. Participants are expected to attend all scheduled events (classes and evening activities) and to write a reflection at the end of week 2. All participants will receive a certificate from Campion Hall and JRS on successful completion of the course.

Drivers of displacement, international protection framework, Global Compact on Refugees and Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration.

WEEK 2 CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING ON FORCIBLY DISPLACED PERSONS

Catholic Social Teaching on real ethical action in the service for refugees.

During the course, participants will have the opportunity to hear from refugees and migrants as well as from experienced JRS workers.
